Present a photo ID and verification of your current mailing address

### **CHECKOUT**

You must present a library card to check items out  
Checkout period is 21 days for district materials, except for video formats  
Videos check out for 7 days  
Patrons are responsible for the safe return of library materials  
Library materials may be returned via an after-hours drop at any VALNet or  
any district library

### **ONLINE SERVICES**

Search the library catalog  
Check your library account, renew materials and place holds online  
Access to databases  
Set up e-mail delivery of hold and overdue notices

### **RENEWALS**

One renewal, provided the item is not on hold for another patron  
May renew in person, by phone, or online  
Videos cannot be renewed

### **HOLDS**

Holds may be placed in person or online  
Patrons may suggest items for purchase

### **INTERLIBRARY LOAN**

WIN-Borrow service via the online catalog allows you to request books from over 2.5  
million titles in Washington-Idaho Network consortium libraries  
Books not available through the library catalog may be  
requested through interlibrary loan

## **FINES & CHARGES**

Video overdue fines: \$0.50 per day

All other district items overdue fines: \$0.10/day

Interlibrary loan overdue fines: \$0.25/day

Fines on items from other libraries may vary

Charges will be assessed for loss or damage to library materials

Please pay all fines promptly. Your privileges are limited by unpaid fines and blocked when fines reach \$5.00

Library card replacement charge: \$1.00

You are responsible for items checked out on your account, so please report lost or stolen cards immediately
