Summer Reading FAQ's:

What is Summer Reading? Think of Summer Reading as a club. Children are encouraged to read 10 books, or for 10 hours or 1000 pages. When they meet one of those goals, they qualify for a free paperback book of their choice and other prizes. In addition, each branch offers fun Summer Reading programs that feature wholesome activities for youth and their families. Check your branch for program times and dates.

Who can participate? Children 0-18. If your child is a pre-reader, you may read to them.

Where, when and how do I register? You may register at your branch library. Signup dates vary, so check your branch's Summer Reading page. In Moscow, registration begins on June 4 and runs through July 24.

Professional entertainment and free book giveaways? That must be expensive. Who pays for it? Summer Reading is sponsored by many generous organizations, but primarily through the Friends groups of each branch library. In Moscow, the Thursday evening programs In the Park are co-sponsored by the Friends of Moscow Library and the Moscow Arts Commission.

What are the rules?

GENERAL

1. Sign-ups begin June 4 in Moscow and continue through July 24. You may sign up during any of the library's open hours.
2. Babies and youth to 18 may participate.
3. Books may be read to or by each child.
3. All program reading must be completed by July 31 (Moscow).
6. Please claim prizes by July 31 (Moscow).
7. Please register at only one branch of the library.
8. Prizes will be given out starting the week of June 18 (Moscow).

READING LOG

1. Each child chooses to read 10 books, 10 hours, or 1000 pages.
2. Record the title of the books, or the time and date, or the title and number of pages on the log.
3. When you have completed your reading, bring the log in to claim your free paperback book and other prizes. Limit of set of prizes per person.
