

Baggie Books

Make this easy “Baggie” book with photographs and pictures of your baby or toddler’s family, friends, pets, and/or favorite things. Let your child play with the book. Encourage her to turn the pages and to say “hi” and the names of the things in her book, e.g., “Hi, Daddy” or “There’s Daddy.” This helps develop her hand-eye coordination.

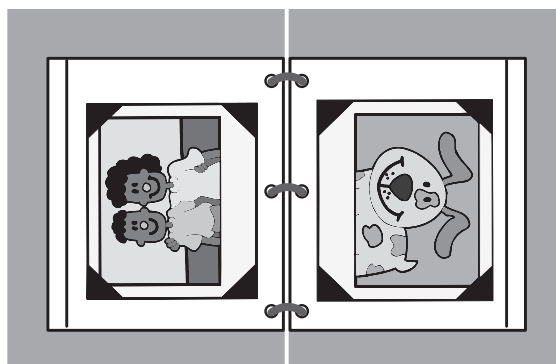
What you need:

- zipper sandwich bags
- two sheets of construction paper
- narrow ribbon
- clip art, photos or copies of photos, magazine pictures
- hole punch
- markers



What you do:

1. Cut out covers from construction paper that are at least an inch larger than the zipper bags.
2. Add zipper bags for the pages.
3. Punch three holes on the non-open end and through the cover.
4. Thread ribbon through the holes.
5. To personalize your book, add family photos or pictures of favorite things to the baggies. Using baggies makes it easy to switch pictures as desired.
6. Decorate the cover with stickers, sequins, or other items and your child’s name.
